REPORT OF COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR

- a. Township Auditorium Mr. Haire, Chair of the Township Board, Mr. Thompson, Township Board member were introduced. Mr. Haire introduced Mrs. Sally Roach, who spoke briefly. A contract with Mrs. Roach has been signed for her to be a management consultant and to have the authority, duties and responsibilities of the Executive Director for a period of six months while the Board determines the process for recruiting for a permanent placement.
- **b. Holopack** There was an explosion at the plant earlier today. Several people were injured.

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- **c. Representative Bill Cotty** Rep. Cotty sent a letter to Council regarding the cigarette tax.
- **d. Trane** SCE&G has provided a \$50,000 grant for the sewer line for the new company.
- **e. Midlands Regional Convention Authority** Council was advised that this organization has changed its name to Midlands Authority for Conventions, Sports and Tourism.

REPORT OF CLERK OF COUNCIL

a. USC Trio Programs – Council received an invitation.

1. REPORT OF DEVELOPMENT AND SERVICES COMMITTEE

- a. Sheriff's Department Storage Building Council approved the award of contract to Crider Construction in the amount of \$194,750.
 ACTION: PROCUREMENT, PUBLIC WORKS, SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT
- b. Broad River Regional Wastewater Treatment Plan Design Council authorized the additional engineering design work to be provided by Power Engineering Company, Inc for an amount not to exceed \$324,885 and also required an assessment report of the chronology of the cost increases and reasons therefore. ACTION: PUBLIC WORKS, PROCUREMENT
- c. HVAC Service Contract Award Council approved a request for a preventive maintenance agreement in the amount of \$50,076 to York International, Inc. for the HVAC chillers and air conditioning equipment in the Judicial Center, the Administration/Health Building, and the Township Auditorium.

d. **Procurement of Articulated Truck** – Council approved the purchase of an A30D Articulated Hauler in the amount of \$268,553.25 for use at the County's C&D Landfill.

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2. REPORT OF ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

- a. Selection of Internal Auditor Council authorized the County
 Administrator to negotiate with and award a contract to the internal
 auditor selected by the Internal Auditor Selection Committee.

- b. Ordinance Establishing Internal Audit Committee Council gave first reading approval to an ordinance establishing an Internal Audit Committee and authorizing its members to oversee the operations of the Internal Auditor reporting to this Committee. ACTION: LEGAL
- Palmetto State Clean Fuels Coalition Council approved a request for the County to be a stakeholder in the Palmetto State Clean Fuels Coalition.
 ACTION: ADMINISTRATION
- **d. Business Improvement District** Council requested the County Administrator to draft and negotiate a contract with the B.I.D. for security, safety, cleaning and other services for the Judicial Center and the Library, not exceeding \$50,000, be presented to Council at the first meeting in September. **ACTION: ADMINISTRATION**
- **3. CITIZEN'S INPUT** No one spoke.

4. MOTION PERIOD/ANNOUNCEMENTS

- **a. McEachern** Requested funds for the Palmetto Classic. Council agreed to fund \$25,000 from the Hospitality Tax and requested a recommendation from the County Administrator regarding how to fund an additional \$25,000.
- **b. McEachern** Requested that the legal department draft criteria for contractors where such criteria gives preference, where possible, to local vendors.
- **c. Pearce** Made a motion without reference for a Commendation to be drafted for Nenie Pasky for her service to the County. Council approved unanimously.
- **d. McEachern** Requested a resolution recognizing Dr. Solomon and Williams and a third unnamed person for being the first African-Americans admitted to the University of South Carolina.

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e. Scott – Requested a letter of endorsement for the Richland County Early Education Council to apply for a grant.
