### Various Site / Civil Airport Improvements (First Phase)

- AIP Grant offered will only cover one phase of construction.
- Additional phases will be requested for construction in the next AIP Grant Cycle.
- Contract awarded to Taylor Brothers.
- Contracts and bonds are executed.
- City of Columbia stormwater permit issued.
- Pre Construction Conference to be scheduled this week.



## AIP Project Updates

### Various Site / Civil Airport Improvements (Second Phase)

- After extensive discussions with the ADO Staff (and multiple ACIP revisions), it appears that the next AIP Grant will cover a second phase of work in the subject project.
- 100% Federally Funded!
- Because of accelerated grant application deadlines imposed by the FAA, we are negotiating with the bidder from one year ago (AOS Specialty Contractors).

- Mar Operational Revenue – \$23,259.28 (Mar '19 - \$23,130.37)

## Airport Metrics

- **Aircraft complaints:**  
There were no (0) aircraft complaints during the period of Mar 1 – Apr 30, 2020.  
There were no (0) identification / Information letters sent (100%).  
There was one (1) aircraft complaint during the same period in 2019.
- **Facilities & Grounds maintenance requests:**  
There were 24 maintenance requests during the period of Mar 1 – Apr 30, 2020.  
Terminal – 46% / Airside – 42% / Landside – 12%  
Hangar related – 25% / Electrical related – 13%  
There were 30 Facilities & Grounds maintenance requests during the same period in 2019.
