Recommendations

- Consent** **A. Ordinance to Amend Section 17-10 of Chapter 17, Motor Vehicles and Traffic** – The Committee recommended that Council approve the ordinance amendment to Chapter 17, Motor Vehicles and Traffic, Article II, General Traffic and Parking Regulations, Section 17-10, Parking in Residential Zones of the County, so as to clarify the prohibition of parking motor vehicles and/or trailers with more than two axles in certain residentially zoned areas of the County.
- Consent** **B. Contract Award: Eastover and Little Camden Paving Project** – The Committee recommended that Council approve the award of a construction contract to Joe Singleton Company, Inc. in the amount of \$446,808.00 for the construction of paved roads in the Town of Eastover and Little Camden Community.
- Consent** **C. Intergovernmental Service Agreements with Arcadia Lakes and Forest Acres** – The Committee recommended that Council approve the intergovernmental agreement as amended (deleting Section I, F), thus allowing Arcadia Lakes and Forest Acres to become co-permittees in the NPDES permitting process. Identical agreements with these two municipalities will go into effect upon execution on behalf of the County and municipalities.
- Consent** **D. Indenture Agreement Granting Right-of-Way to SCE&G for Electric Lines Serving Skateboard Park on Jim Hamilton Boulevard** – The Committee recommended that Council grant the easement to SEC&G for installation of electric lines to serve the skateboard park on Jim Hamilton Boulevard.
- Consent** **E. Contract Award: Chartwell Drainage Project** – The Committee recommended that Council award the construction contract to the low bidder, CBG, Inc., in the amount of \$128,709.77.
- Consent** **F. Amendments to the Animal Care Ordinance** – The Committee recommended that Council approve an ordinance that amends Richland County’s Animal Care Ordinance.
