- 2) Grade, School, School Address and Teacher
- 3) Identify subject and location of photo taken
- 4) Each participant may enter 2 photos
- 5) Name of each person in photo if any
- 6) Photos become the property of Richland Farm- City Committee, and they reserve the right to use all photographs in their publications, on their web site, and for conservation promotion purposes. Entrants should keep negatives or extra prints of their photos.
- 7) Entries must be received by October 19, 2009 at the Richland Soil & Water Conservation District Office at 2020 Hampton Street, Rm., 3063A, Columbia, SC 29204.
- 8) **Winners will be recognized at the Annual Awards Luncheon on Tuesday, November 17, 2009.**
